BE STILL a study on Psalm 46:10

What you will need: your Bible, a pen, this study sheet, a quiet place, a timer.

1. Sit in your quiet place. Remove as many distractions as you can. Read Psalm 46:10:

"Be still, and know that I am God.
I will be exalted among the nations,
I will be exalted in the earth!"
- Psalm 46:10

- 2. Set a timer for three minutes. Close your eyes and let your mind rest on God. After the timer goes off, journal your thoughts below.
 - a. What did you "see" or think about?
 - b. Did three minutes seem long or short to you? Did your mind wander?
- 3. The Hebrew word that translates as "be still" in the ESV is הַּרְפָּוּ ($har \cdot p\bar{u}$.) It comes from the root רָפָה ($raphah^1$) which means to sink or relax.

Look up the following verses. How does each verse impact your understanding of "being still"?

 $^{^1}$ note that although pronounced similarly, the word raphah הַּכָּה is not the same as rapha בְּכָּא which means "to heal," and which is one of the names of the Lord – Jehovah Rapha, God our Healer.
