Study

1. Read all of Deuteronomy 30 this week. What stands out to you? Underline in your Bible, or make notes here to come back to later.

2. Read Romans 10:6-10 . To what did Paul apply Deuteronomy 30:12-14? What does this mean to us today?

3. For the context of Deuteronomy 30, research the Mosaic and Palestinian Covenants. (Exodus 19-24 and Deuteronomy 29 and 30:1-10.) Use a site like Biblehub.com or Gotquestions.org. What stands out to you?

4. Why had the Israelites not been allowed to enter the Promised Land for 40 years? Read Numbers 13:16-18, 13:26-14:2, and 14:28-34.

5. Are there any areas in your life where you tend to disbelieve or disobey? Write them down. Pray that God would help you focus on Him and obey His voice.
