



## SCRIPTURE MEMORY CHALLENGE

### Deuteronomy 30:13

“Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, ‘Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?’”

### Study

1. Re-read this week’s verse. Do you tend to look for truth, wisdom, or direction outside of God? If so, in what ways? Pray to be aware of God’s nearness.
2. Read John 14:15-26. How does this passage relate to this week’s verse? Write down any thoughts you have.
3. Pagan philosophers once travelled long distances to seek wisdom and spiritual enlightenment. They would “go to get.” Christians are told to “go share.” Read Matthew 28:19-20. What does Jesus tell us?
4. We are not all called to be traveling missionaries, but we are all called to participate in missions. Pray for ways you can help spread the Gospel.
5. Moses mentions obedience, which is important to God (see also John 14:15). Read Galatians 5:16-26 and Romans 8:1-11. How does the Spirit help us? Journal your thoughts.
