Find the context the OT passage:	Positive message describing life in God's house- as meant to be: Blessed and for "all nations" v.1 - salvation coming soon	Negative message Rebuke for profaning the house of the Lord
Synthesize What You Learned	Prefiguring 1. Jesus reminds the people that God's house is for His people and purpose 2. Claims to be God "My House"	Pattern 1. You, Israel have done this before 2. Chastises them for making God's house into something it wasn't meant to be.
